**Medical Assisting Associate Degree**

For the 2020 Medical Assisting Education Review Board (MAERB) Annual Report, Bryant & Stratton College submitted the total number of Medical Assisting graduates who participated in and passed a national medical assisting certification exam. Bryant & Stratton College graduates performed at a 61% passing rate
