Medical Assisting Associate Degrees

According to Commission on the Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP), accredited programs in Medical Assisting must be periodically assessed for effectiveness in achieving their stated goals and learning domains. The results of this evaluation must be reflected in the review and timely revision of the program. The program must meet defined outcomes and assessment thresholds.

For the 2019 Medical Assisting Education Review Board (MAERB) Annual Report, Bryant & Stratton College submitted the total number of Medical Assisting graduates who participated in and passed a national medical assisting certification exam. Bryant & Stratton College graduates performed at a 75% passing rate.

Nursing Associate Degree (Ohio, Wisconsin and Virginia only)

In 2019, there were 304 Bryant & Stratton College graduates who took the NCLEX exam and 261 students who passed the exam. Bryant & Stratton College graduates performed at an 85.85% passing rate.
