

## **Bryant & Stratton College Retention Performance**

A measure of student persistence that institutions use for reporting retention performance reflects data that tracks students in a starting cohort to determine the percentage of students retained one year later. Although the college reviews retention on a term by term basis, for purposes of this report, the College tracked the September and November 2021 new student cohorts and their status one year later.

For the 2021 cohort of new students to Bryant & Stratton College, including first time and transfer students, there was a total of 4,553 certificate- or degree-seeking students enrolled across the system of colleges for the September and November semesters. Of these students, the College retained or graduated 1,819 students as of one year later which resulted in a 40.0% retention rate. This includes:

- 1,365 Diploma students, of whom 477 (34.9%) were retained or graduated
- 2,359 2-year Associate degree students, of whom 887 (37.6%) were retained or graduated
- 367 2.5-year Associate degree students\*, of whom 220 (59.9%) were retained or graduated
- 462 Bachelor's degree students, of whom 235 (50.9%) were retained or graduated
  
- 1,236 first-time, full-time students, of whom 445 (36.0%) were retained or graduated
- 64 first-time, part-time students, of whom 15 (23.4%) were retained or graduated
- 2,877 non-first-time, full-time students, of whom 1,181 (41.0%) were retained or graduated
- 376 non-first-time, part-time students, of whom 178 (47.3%) were retained or graduated

\* The College's Nursing, Occupational Therapy Assistant, and Physical Therapy Assistant Associate degree programs require 72, 73, and 71 credit hours, respectively, to complete.
