

RETENTION OUTCOME (SOURCE: MAERB 2019 ARF REPORT)

MAERB requires that all programs publish at least one outcome, with the option of publishing more than one, from the MAERB Annual Report Form. The published outcome data must be the single-year figure from the year prior to the most recent year reported. The chart below represents 2017 retention data.
